Tasks will include improvements such as painting playgrounds & benches, pruning, path maintenance and construction, habitat management, gardening and litter picking.

We can host groups of between 8-40 individuals. If your team have a background in construction, design and engineering and are keen to share your skills and experience, just let us know and we can match you to a suitable project.

What we will provide

- Team leader project briefing ahead of the day
- Appropriate co-ordination throughout the project.
- Undertake a risk assessment...
- Tools and equipment, including appropriate PPE where specified.
- Indemnity insurance.
- A fun, rewarding and morale boosting days work, making a real difference to local communities and the health and wellbeing of your staff.

What we need from you

- Appropriate outdoor clothing, sturdy footwear and good quality gardening gloves.
- Bring your own lunch & refreshments.
- No experience necessary, just a willingness to get stuck in and have fun!

Whilst participation in our volunteering activities is free, many of the projects require materials or extra tools and equipment, for which we may request a contribution from your organisation to purchase. If funding is required for a project, this will be stated in the project brief.
